## “Together Again” at HAEi’s Global Leadership Workshop

Last month, we participated in HAEi’s Global Leadership Workshop in Frankfurt, Germany.

The Workshop’s theme was “Together Again,” a celebration of nearly 500 advocacy leaders, researchers, physicians, and pharmaceutical representatives reuniting for HAEi’s first global, in-person meeting in 4 years.

HAEi curated two days of extensive content. The Advocacy Leadership track highlighted the incredible variety of services and programs HAEi offers to its network of 95 worldwide advocacy organizations. This includes providing software and website hosting, creating and publishing translated awareness materials, creating an “Advocacy Academy” to provide guidance for building and growing an organization, and conducting country-level and regional-level research to help advance understanding of the disease and access to treatments. The scientific track featured leading physicians and scientists, who presented research on two key topics: “Improving Diagnosis and Management” and “Normalizing Patients’ Lives.”

**Data from these presentations continued to quantify what we’ve heard resoundingly from the community: the difficult journey to diagnosis, the immense mental and physical toll of HAE attacks, and the desire for treatments that allow people to live their lives without limitation.**

Outside of sessions, we had the opportunity to learn from advocacy leaders and physicians from dozens of different countries. These conversations provided insight into the unique experiences and challenges of living with HAE in different parts of the world. We are excited to have made many friendships and look forward to applying these learnings to our work!

## About STAR-0215

Our team is committed to the development of a new investigational product, **STAR-0215**, that could provide an effective preventative treatment, dosed once every 3 months or longer.

We anticipate preliminary results from our ongoing Phase 1a trial in healthy volunteers by year-end. Provided the data from the Phase 1a trial is favorable, we anticipate initiating a Phase 1b/2 trial in people with HAE in the first quarter of 2023.
