**Position Overview:**

Astria Therapeutics is dedicated to bringing hope with life-changing therapies to patients and families affected by allergic and immunological diseases. Astria’s pipeline includes our lead program, STAR-0215, a monoclonal antibody inhibitor of plasma kallikrein in clinical development for the treatment of hereditary angioedema, as well as STAR-0310, an OX40 monoclonal antibody antagonist currently in preclinical development for atopic dermatitis (AD) and being explored for other allergic and immunological diseases.

The Director, Corporate Counsel, Clinical and Privacy will report to Astria’s CLO (who also oversees Quality, Regulatory and Government Affairs), be responsible for overseeing all legal, compliance and other matters for Astria within the CMO/Medical Services functions (which includes medical, medical affairs, clinical development, clinical operations and PV/safety), IT/privacy/data protection, patient advocacy, quality, and regulatory.

**Responsibilities:**

- Serve as Legal representative on clinical, program and program-related teams and certain other cross-functional teams
- Serve as lead legal reviewer for all contracts within the CMO/Medical Services, commercial/new product planning (NPP), IT/privacy/data protection, patient advocacy, quality, and regulatory functions, and other functions, as necessary, and oversee the legal aspects of a broad array of contracts generally within his/her domain; including reviewing, revising, drafting, and negotiating.
- Serve as lead legal and compliance advisor for CMO/Medical Services functions, IT/privacy, patient advocacy, quality, and regulatory functions, which includes providing legal and business counsel, and establishing and influencing appropriate ethical standards and legal considerations.
- In partnership with the CLO and other members of the Legal team, providing overall leadership and management of legal matters within his/her domain by facilitating strategically important corporate initiatives, and advising the CEO and the leadership team on the legal aspects of key transactions and ongoing negotiations.
- Partner with the CLO, leading all aspects of litigation, disputes, investigations and related matters within his/her domain and advising the CEO and the leadership team on such matters.
- Develop and evolve a global data privacy/protection and general compliance program within his/her domain that adequately meets the needs and stage of Astria.
- Partner with the CLO and other members of the Legal team to develop, implement, and manage the provision of legal and compliance services for Astria, to include resource/work force planning and management, long-range planning and budgeting.
- Assist in selecting and managing external counsel and other advisors.
